



Employment Opportunity – Skills Link 2 FTE and 1 Short term FTE

The Thunderchild First Nation is looking for Youth ages 15-30 years of age who are not in school nor employed. **The duration of the 2 positions is now to March 31, 2025, and 1 position from now to July 16th, 2024.**

The Skills Link program aims to:

- to support the development and enhancement of essential employability skills and knowledge among First Nations youth to enable to participate and succeed in the current and future labor markets, such as communication skills, problem solving and working with others.
- to expose youth to a variety of career options
- to help youth acquire skills by providing wage subsidies for mentored work experiences.
- to support the provision of mentored school-based work and study opportunities such as co-operative education and internships
- to help First Nations youth overcome barriers to employment.
- to promote the roles of education and skills in successfully participating in the labor market

Job Summary

- The Youth will be placed in positions within the First Nations' administration departments (Lands, Public Works/Housing, Education, Culture/Recreation, etc.) and or business operations and supervised by the respective Program Manager/ Department head.
- He/she will be involved in planning, organizing, participating, monitoring program /dept events, activities, projects, and learn about organization, decision making, conflict resolution, leadership, management and use of office equipment.

Qualifications

- willing to work and take direction.
- willing to learn new skills and abilities.
- must be punctual and possess good communication skills.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Ahere to all applicable Thunderchild laws and policies
- Demonstrate knowledge of First Nation traditions, customs and world view.
- Respect for Indigenous culture and willingness to learn Cree.
